

## **A Call for Literary Contributions to *San Vitores Theological Review***

### **Articles**

- The *San Vitores Theological Review* is a peer review journal. While the responsibility for the acceptance of articles to be published in the *Review* shall ultimately be that of the editor, he should be guided by the judgment of the reviewers.
- In making his judgment, the editor shall ensure that the articles are in accord with the clear teaching of the magisterium of the Church.
- Translations of articles published in other journals shall only be accepted with permission of the author and those who hold the copyrights.
- Articles submitted for publication shall be considered as contributions and fees or other compensation shall not be made.
- Authors shall be asked to assign copyrights to the *Review*. The editor shall follow a liberal policy of granting permission for republication when requested.

### **Subject Matter of Articles**

- The *Review* shall consider for publication articles dealing with any of the subjects taught in the *San Vitores Theological Institute*. This includes theological, philosophical, and cultural topics, with a special consideration to the evangelization.

### **Language of the *Review***

- Articles in English, Italian, Spanish, French, German, and any of the Pacific languages shall be deemed worthy of publication.
- The editor will consider translations for worthy articles in other languages that are not generally accessible to our readership.

### **Frequency of Publication**

- The journal is published yearly.

### **Style Sheet**

- The *Review* shall follow the style sheet of *Theological Studies* with whatever modifications the editor will deem advisable. Permission for the use of its style sheet has been granted by the editor of *Theological Studies*.
- English spelling shall follow standard American practice (Webster's Dictionary).

### **Method of Submission of Articles**
